**Simon Leach** was educated in Somerset, U.K. and spent many years honing his craft. He has traveled extensively in Europe, the Middle East, the U.S. and Canada. For six years, he operated a pottery/showroom in Spain, using stoneware, porcelain and raku, teaching and demonstrating two week workshops. His experience includes firing in wood, gas, oil, raku, and electric kilns and he has built a gas kiln for studio production.
